

VILLAGE HALL REPRESENTATIVE REPORT FOR FCC MEETING ON WEDNESDAY 13th MARCH 2024

The Porlock village hall management committee AGM took place at 7.30 PM on Monday 4th March and was followed by the management committee meeting. Minutes for these meeting are available if required.

At the management committee meeting these items were of note for PPC:

- I asked the committee about the viability of having a defibrillator housed on the outside of the village hall building. It was discussed that it would be good to have a defibrillator at this end of the village and the village hall could be a good option. Problems highlighted were that of providing an electrical supply to an outside wall. Also, the funding required for the annual maintenance and servicing of the device, which is not insignificant. The maintenance group agreed to look into what was needed to facilitate an electrical supply. Annual costing can be discussed by PPC if reasonable solutions are found for mounting the defibrillator.
- There is still confusion regarding the village hall boundaries. It was agreed that PPC would provide copies of the deeds including a map showing the village hall boundaries. They are concerned about insurance implications and boundary wall issues etc.
