1. Apologies

All councillors were present.

2. <u>Declarations of Interest and Disclosable Pecuniary Interest Dispensations.</u>

Cllr. Stanyon wished to note an interest with Agenda Item 9.

3. To review and Recommend APPROVAL to Full Council the transfer to ear marked reserves.

The Clerk provided a brief background for the Ear Marked funds and the origins of the funds to be allocated as listed below:

It was highlighted that during the save the bus campaign which took place in 2017 the public raised £2,984.34 to contribute to the retention of the bus service and part of this fund could be used for a publicity campaign which would involve a leaflet drop including bus information and a timetable. FC RECOMMEND the amount of £2,984.34 is transferred to an EMF labelled Transport.
