### **Grass Cutting**

Through the main growing season April to September, council have identified areas that will take a multi maintenance approach to create areas for wildflowers and to encourage wildlife. This approach aims to address the balance between keeping the village green spaces tidy while supporting council's responsibility to enhance biodiversity. To support this approach Council will explore options to create designated managed wildflower areas and not just allow weeds and invasive species to take hold.

- **Level 1** Bowling green length (Short Cut)
- Level 2 Park length (Medium cut)
- Level 3 Meadow Length (Wildflower areas left to grow April September while in flower)

### Cemetery Maintenance

Due to the landscape and nature of the cemetery multiple approaches are required in the grounds. The overall aim is to maintain the cemetery with respect for its residents. The full range of grounds maintenance tasks are listed below:

- Cut main areas with mower
- Strim graves high areas
- Trim hedge at Lynch gate
- Cut around entrance
- Cut and maintain all hedges and laurels on boundaries
- Spray steps and paths and keep tidy
- Keep steps and safety rails maintained (subject to be repaired)
- Trim yew tree surrounding Chibbet grave
- Remove all green waste, bracken and fallen branches
- Remove 40 dump bags of leaves waste each autumn
- Level graves (every 3 years) requires mini digger to remove soil waste and stones from graves
- Redress graves with good quality soil and sow grass seed
- Soil waste to be removed by specialist contractor
- North boundary, grave diggers waste requires removal on a regular basis (should be put in soil compound not along boundary)
