green space and the removal of the mature trees that occupy it, should it be developed. It was also agreed that any such development would cause disruption to the water table and significantly increase the risk of flooding to the adjacent business, as raised in the environment agency report. The committee agreed that it supported companies like Falcon Rural Housing in their objective to build more social rented housing in the village, but felt that other sites in the village would be more suitable, and that any such future developments should not be at the cost of losing vital green space or the aesthetics of the village.

The Committee RESOLVED not to support Falcon Rural Housing's plans to develop the Porlock Picnic Site and put their recommendation to Council at the next ordinary meeting on the 11th September '24.
