Membership

A minimum of one member of the Council plus members from the community

Working Group Protocols

All Members appointed to a Working Group will be deemed to have accepted the Working Group Protocol and the terms of reference for the Working Group as approved by Council. The Parish Council's Code of Conduct applies to any Councillors who are members of this working group. Volunteers will also be requested to follow the Code and not to act individually but according to actions agreed within the working group. All GDPR regulations will be adhered to when dealing with the personal details of residents and others.

Delegated Powers

The working group has delegated powers to purchase required items within the approved budget of £500. The allocated budget will be spent as agreed by the working group and endorsed by the lead councillor. The purpose of the working group is to report to the Council on its areas of responsibility and tasks (see below) and make recommendations to the Council.

Areas of responsibility

The purpose of the working group is to light up Porlock with lights and Christmas trees during December and early January. The working group will report to the Council

Tasks

The main activities of the working group are (but not limited to) the following:

• To sort and maintain the strings of lights which are kept in the Village Hall cellar.
